Keith Surridge, Professor of History, Ph.D (King's College London), F.R.Hist. S.

Keith Surridge has taught history at the University of Notre Dame London Global Gateway for over twenty years. His publications include Managing the South African War, 1899-1902, Politicians vrs Generals (1998) and (with Denis Judd), The Boer War (2002). His current research interests focus on British India's north-west frontier during the late nineteenth-century, however, his real passion is English football. He has occasionally held lectures on the history of English football for London Global Gateway students and is also quiz master at the biannual student pub quiz.
